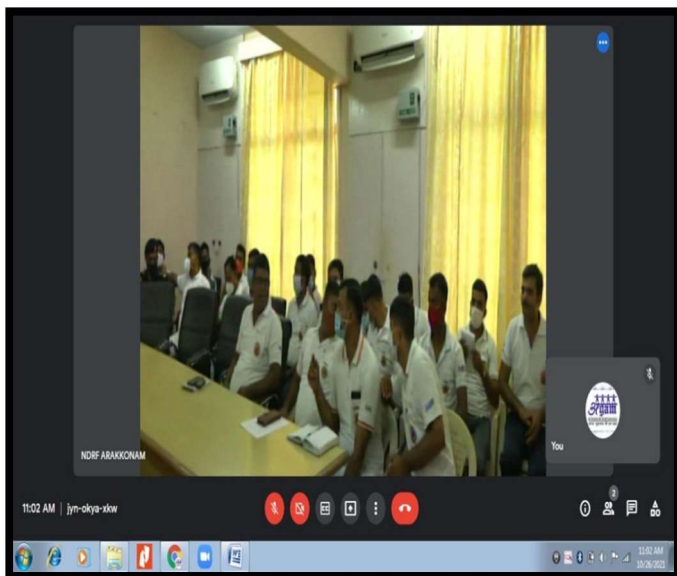
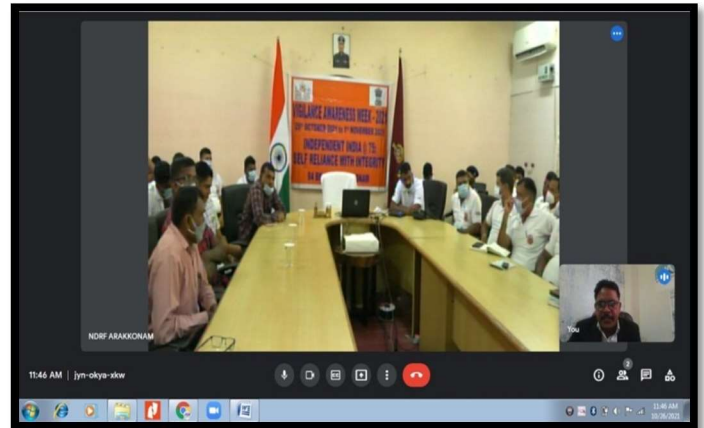

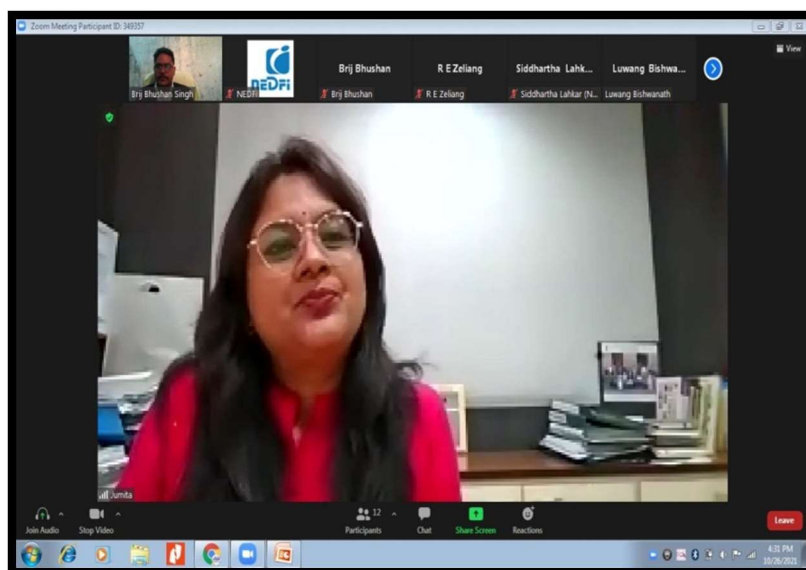

The theme of the session was “Independent India @75: Self Reliance with Integrity”. They gave a motivational talk to the Public at large. Mr. Brij Bhushan Singh was main speaker representing AGAM and was also coordinator of this successful webinar.



The team discussed how the Central Vigilance team monitors all vigilance activities under the Central Government and advise various authorities in Central Government and organizations under it, in planning, executing and reviewing their vigilance work in order to bring out systemic improvement in governance. In addition, the Commission with its outreach activities also endeavors to create awareness amongst the common man, especially the youth, towards the policy of achieving transparency, accountability and corruption free governance.

On the very first day of the Vigilance week, a panel discussion was organized by the AGAM especially for the student community. 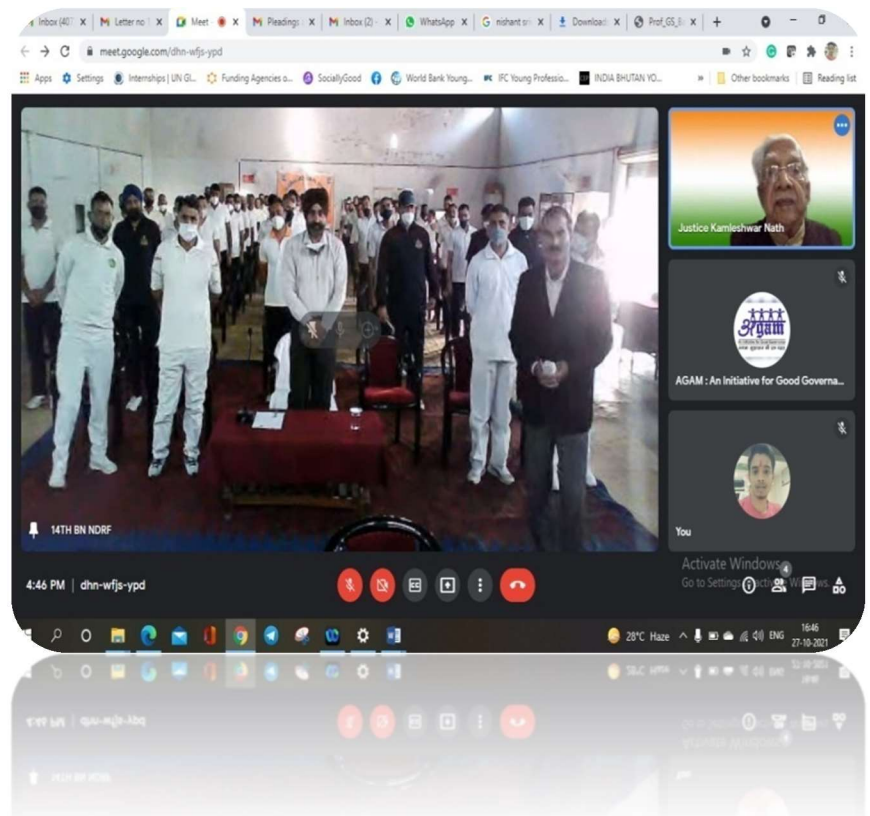


A MOTIVATIONAL TALK SHOW BY JUSTICE KAMLESHWAR NATH
